FIELD RULES AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) membership is required for all pilots. This flying site is an AMA charted field and every pilot must be familiar and comply with all AMA Rules and Regulations. (see <http://www.modelaircraft.org>)
- Guests who are not AMA members are permitted to fly only when accompanied by, and under the supervision of, a LVSC member.
- Frequency control is the responsibility of each pilot. Make sure you are displaying a frequency pin prior to turning transmitter is turned ON.
- Once in the air stand at least eight (8) feet back from the edge of the runway. This is not only a safety precaution but you will find that you hit the runway more often when you stand back.
- The flight line must not be used as a pit area for repairs or major adjustments.
- Gliders and dead stick powered models are to be given priority for landing. Always call out when you are landing and the status (i.e. "landing, dead stick".)
- When a glider pilot calls for landing, powered models are to clear the approach and landing area if possible. Glider pilots should also call "dead stick" to insure that anyone flying that he/she cannot go around.
- Once landed you must call out your intention (i.e. "on the runway"), and immediately retrieve your aircraft and clear the runway. Once you are clear of the runway you must call out "runway is clear."
- Winch training is required to operate winch.
- ABSOLUTELY NO flying south of the runway of over HWY 160. This means that all glider pilots must turn north of the winch line after being released from the winch.
- All new pilots must demonstrate competent flying skills before flying at this site to a senior member of the club.
- When at the field, we are all safety officers. If you see someone not complying with these rules, please bring it to their attention. If you feel uncomfortable doing this, bring it to the attention of one of the club officers.
- Visitors must remain in the pit area unless accompanied by a LVSC member.

Compliance with these rules and regulations will ensure the safety of everyone at this flying site and preserve the integrity of our hobby for generations to come.
